## Memorandum

In a continued effort to provide transparency surrounding COVID-19 at The Village at Rockville, we are providing an update due to an increase in our positive number of cases of COVID-19 since our previous update on Thursday, April 16. We continue to work closely with the Montgomery County Department of Health and the epidemiologists with the State of Maryland. To provide more frequent information outside of our written communications, we have developed a dashboard that provides specific information on COVID-19 at The Village at Rockville. The dashboard will be updated daily by 4 p.m. and can be found at this <u>link</u>.

Currently, our direct care team members are utilizing face shields, KN95 masks (or greater) and gloves. Gown use is prioritized to high-risk care activities and for those under isolation protocols. For non-direct care team members, face masks are worn throughout the building at all times.

As we speak of personal protective equipment (PPE), we have received overwhelming support by a number of community partners who have donated a variety of PPE, including fabric masks, surgical masks, N95 masks and face shields. We are inspired by their generosity while so many are under their own hardships during this time.
