Subject: Health Center in-person visits suspended

Memorandum

Late Sunday evening, March 14, we learned that one of our team members tested positive for COVID-19. One positive test result from either a resident or team member is classified by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) as an “outbreak.” Following the Maryland Department of Health and CMS guidelines, ***we must suspend our in-person indoor visits effective immediately*** until community-wide testing is completed to ensure that this positive test result is isolated.

Salon services, socially-distanced communal dining and small group programming will continue during this time. We will continue practicing infection control protocols with properly using personal protection equipment, washing hands and disinfecting high-touch and common areas.

The ConnectedLiving team is working through the in-person visit schedule to offer virtual visits during this period. We know that this is a disappointment to everyone, and we will continue to communicate our ability to resume in-person visitation in the near future.
