**Subject:** Health Center Path Forward update

## Memorandum

Following guidance from the Maryland Department of Health, with the decrease of Montgomery County COVID-19 transmission levels, the following visitation protocols are effective as of **Saturday, February 19, 2022:** 

- Visitors no longer need to test or show proof of testing for COVID-19 prior to visiting
- Upon each entry to the Health Center
  - Visitors must complete the COVID-19 screening
  - Show proof of COVID-19 vaccination
  - Perform hand hygiene (alcohol-based hand sanitizer acceptable)
  - o Put on a fresh mask provided at the front desk of the Health Center.
- Any visitor who cannot follow masking and social distancing requirements will not be allowed to visit.
- If you have recently tested positive for COVID-19, visitors may not visit for a minimum of ten days from the positive test date, as long as they are no longer exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19.
- Children younger than two years old are not authorized to visit.
- Guests can visit anytime throughout the day but may not stay overnight.
- We encourage a maximum of two visitors in each resident's room or apartment at a time for physical distancing.
- Visitors are authorized to be in a resident's room/apartment or in designation visitation areas. Visitors may not join in any programming/activities at this time.

Please note visitor testing requirements will change based on the COVID-19 transmission rate within Montgomery County, current testing requirements will be noted on the <u>Path Forward page of our website</u>. Visitors should use this page as a resource to understand the status of testing requirements prior to their visit.
