Re: Mask requirement updates

The time has come to update our masking policies based on recommendations from the CDC and the Maryland Department of Health. **Effective Monday, May 22, in the Health Center, masking is recommended but not required.** The CDC will no longer be collecting transmission rates, so they have instructed health care providers to follow the hospital admission numbers.

Masks will be required if our locale goes "above" specific respiratory illness hospitalization numbers OR if the Health Center is in outbreak, which is defined as at least one active case of COVID-19. In order to communicate expectations and protocols more clearly, we are implementing a color-coded mask status system, which is based on the guidance provided by the Department of Health and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid.

## **GREEN**

Masks are <u>OPTIONAL</u>. Feel free to request a mask from the front desk as you desire.

## **YELLOW**

Masks are

ENCOURAGED due to high respiratory illness in the county/state.

## RED

Masks are <u>REQUIRED</u> for all who enter the Health Center.

Mask status is monitored and updated weekly based on the Maryland Department of Health respiratory illness hospitalization rates. Additionally, if any section of the Health Center is in an outbreak status, masks will be required for any person entering. Notices will be posted at the entrance of the Health Center.

As a reminder, visitors should NOT visit the community when ill (in any manner not just respiratory) and must follow all guidelines for visitation to the community, which can be found on the <a href="Path Forward page">Path Forward page</a> of our website. We will continue to follow our guidelines our enhanced surface cleaning.

We are excited to be able to take this step in our COVID-19 recovery. Thank you in advance for your continued partnership in taking the best steps to keep our community safe.
